We have discharged over **414 individuals** since the beginning of our initiative, which began in **October of 2011**

Number of individuals who have died after moving from TC = 18 – this spans the period from October 2011- present.

Of the people who have moved, **19 individuals have discharged to a Nursing Facility**. One person moved to a MH facility and is being transferred to another TC, per AR request.
