

Licensing Regulation 12VAC35-105-520.A. states that the provider shall designate a person responsible for the risk management function who has completed department approved training, which shall include training related to risk management, understanding of individual risk screening, conducting investigations, root cause analysis, and the use of data to identify risk patterns and trends.

Below is a crosswalk of DBHDS approved trainings that once taken will fulfill the requirements of 12 VAC35-105-520.A. Please note the person responsible for risk management must also complete the Risk Management Attestation. The attestation shall also be signed and dated by the person’s direct supervisor. The attestation does not need to be submitted directly to the Office of Licensing when completed but must be kept on file and presented when requested by the Office of Licensing, including when requested during onsite and remote inspections. **Revisions to the Crosswalk of Approved Risk Management Training issued in January 2021 are highlighted in yellow.**

The first column in the crosswalk below lists individual DBHDS approved trainings. The second column lists the components of 12VAC35-105-520.A. that will be considered met upon completion of the individual training/course. The third column includes the hyperlink to the approved training for ease of access. Once the person responsible for the risk management function completes or reviews each individual training, they should complete the Risk Management Attestation discussed above.

In lieu of completing each of the trainings listed in the crosswalk below, DBHDS has also approved the courses offered by the Center for Developmental Disabilities Evaluation and Research (CDDER) to meet the regulatory requirements for 12VAC35-105-520.A. A provider’s designated person responsible for the risk management function will be considered to have met the training requirements of 520.A. (except training in conducting investigations) by participating in the CDDER webinar (live or recorded as posted on the Office of Licensing website). The hyperlink to the complete CDDER training can be found in crosswalk below. If the person responsible for the risk management function completes the CDDER training, they will need to document their participation or review of the training as well as their participation in the investigation training on the Risk Management Attestation.

Through CDDER/ University of Massachusetts Medical School, DBHDS offers courses on the development and implementation of risk management processes that meet Virginia's requirements to identify and mitigate risk, while establishing a culture of continuous quality improvement. The courses provide practical knowledge for monitoring and oversight and include access to tools, interactive forms, checklists and resources to guide risk management efforts.

One individual license per course will be available free of cost to each DBHDS Developmental services provider. Each DBHDS Developmental services provider will be given a license for one person to take each of the four courses listed below free of cost. Risk Management and System Design in Developmental Disabilities:

1. Risk Screening in Developmental Disabilities

Learn how to recognize and plan for the mitigation of health and safety risks for people with disabilities.

2. Incident Management in Developmental Disabilities

Learn how to build a system to identify, notify, trigger, analyze, inform and document incidents. A good system will promote and direct safety and quality improvement.

3. Root Cause Analysis in Developmental Disabilities

A structured approach and process guide to analyze significant adverse events to understand why the events occurred and how to prevent events going forward.

4. Data Analysis for Quality Improvement

Objective measurement and analysis is a powerful management tool; learn how to use data effectively, understanding the benefits and limitations of incident data.

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The person responsible for risk management shall attest to completion of required training by signing and dating this DBHDS Risk Management Attestation. The attestation shall also be signed and dated by the person's direct supervisor.

DBHDS Risk Management (RM) Attestation

The attestation does not need to be submitted directly to the Office of Licensing when completed but must be kept on file and presented when requested by the Office of Licensing, including when requested during onsite and remote inspections.
