CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Denton Staley, Chairperson, called the Local Human Rights Subcommittee (LHRC) meeting to order at 12:45 P.M. on Tuesday, March 22, 2016, at Southwestern Virginia Mental Health Institute, Learning Center Dogwood Room.

CLOSED SESSION

Ms. Mathena moved that the LHRC go into closed session pursuant to VA Code §2.2-3711.A. (4) and (15) for the purpose of protecting the privacy of individuals in personal matters not related to public business and the discussion of medical and mental records, namely to conduct a review of informed consent related to treatment with Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT). Ms. Jones seconded the motion. The Chair requested all in favor to signify by saying "Yes" and all those opposed indicate by saying, "No." The motion carried.

Ms. Jones moved that the LHRC return to open session with a second by Ms. Mathena. The motion carried unanimously. The Chairperson asked each member to certify that to the best of their knowledge only matters lawfully exempted from open meetings requirements were heard, discussed, or considered. Each member replied "I so certify."

Ms. Mathena made the motion regarding the Review of Informed Consent to ECT. Having heard the testimony from Dr. Everett Jones and reviewed the material evidence including but not limited to the record appointing the Authorized Representative and the written informed consent, the LHRC finds that Southwestern Virginia Mental Health Institute has obtained informed consent in
