REVIEW OF ECT (Closed Session)

The motion was made and passed to go into Closed Session pursuant to Virginia Code §2.2-3711.A.(4) and (15), for the protection of privacy of individuals in personal matters not related to public business and to review medical records, namely to conduct a review pursuant to the regulations.

Dr. Monika Pelly, Psychiatrist, was present to request that the LHRC review whether SWVMHI had obtained proper consent for ECT for Patient C. Dr. Ade Ladenika is the client's attending psychiatrist, but today is his regular day off and he was unable to attend.

Upon reconvening in public session, the Local Human Rights Committee unanimously certified that only public business matters lawfully exempt from statutory open meeting requirements, and only public business matters identified in the motion to convene the Closed session were discussed in the Closed session.

A motion was made by Rachel Jones to validate that the facility had met all criteria indicated by the Human Rights Regulations, Departmental Instructions, and memorandum from former Commissioner James S. Reinhard, M.D., dated 8/2/04 in reference to ECT for this patient. The motion was seconded by Jo Ann Johns, and it was unanimously approved.
