He discussed self advocacy and recovery in addition to a new policy with regards to patients and cell phones he is working on. Mr. Thomas will be doing a FOIA (Freedom of Information Act) training session at the next LHRC meeting. Zachary Devore presented information from VOPA. He noted that there will be one representative present at future meetings instead of two. Mr. Devore also discussed Mental Health bills that are in currently in process through the General Assembly.

Complaints, Barriers to Discharge List, and the IFPC Minutes were reviewed by the committee.

Gail Burford provided the committee with an update of the internet availability on patients' computers. She also mentioned details about the new guard house being positioned at the front entrance to the hospital.

With no further business to discuss, and a motion from Linda Thumma and a second from Donna Gum, the meeting was adjourned.
