# **Training Center Closure Information**

• In June 2011 the 5 Training Center Census was 1084. As of June 22, 2017 the census was 286.

- SWVTC is scheduled to close by June 2018
- CVTC is scheduled to close by June 2020
- SEVTC will remain open with the capacity to serve 75 individuals

- 4 additional individuals have providers ready to support them and families are making final decisions
- 6 individuals are actively considering their options
- Census is expected to reach:
  - 70 by June 30, 2017
  - o **0 by June 30, 2018**

- The majority of individuals have remained within their home region.
  - In Home Region –127
  - o Out of Home Region-54

#### • 144 Individuals remain at CVTC

- 9 individuals have identified homes
- 7 additional individuals have providers ready to support them and families are making final decisions
- 9 individuals are actively considering their options
- 61 individuals are working with Community Integration Staff to consider options
- $\circ$  58 individuals are not considering options at this time

#### • Census is expected to reach:

- 143 by June 30, 2017
- o **0 by June 30, 2020**
