Everything you need to know about Skin Integrity and Pressure Injury

The Registered Nurse Care Consultants (RNCC) with the Office of Integrated Health – Health Support Network (OIH-HSN) at the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (DBHDS) will be providing a training on general skin integrity and pressure injuries.

This training will cover factors which can cause skin breakdown, how to provide good skin care while bathing, positioning and changing individuals with high personal care needs. What role the direct care staff play in preventing skin breakdown and recognizing the need to report changes in the skin to the right healthcare member. The healthcare professionals who are involved in the treatment of pressure injuries, how to prevent pressure injury, and an understanding of how to properly document health issues of individuals at risk for pressure injury or with skin breakdown.

This training will review all the important aspects of good skin integrity and the benefit it plays on the overall health of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (DD). Attendees will receive a certificate of participation and educational handouts along with the training presentation.
