Vital Signs	The training will review what are vital signs, why taking a set of vital signs is important, who needs orders for taking vital signs, protocols and parameters of vital signs. The training thoroughly explains blood pressure, pulse, temperature, respirations, and oxygen levels, how to develop the skill of taking vital signs, what are normal ranges, and when is seek help is vital sign ranges are outside of normal. VDH Special Needs Oral Health	The training reviews strategies to support clients who need improved oral care and prevent diseases of the mouth. This training will provide an overview of fire emergencies, and help develop a well thought out plan to lower risk of injury for individual's with IDD and their caregivers during a fire emergency situation. When to seek medical health, how to get a clean catch urine sample, and how to handle urine specimens, and how UTI can lead to sepsis.
