

Introducing the Mobile Rehab Engineering Team at OIH/DBHDS

The Office of Integrated Health (OIH) at the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health & Developmental Services (DBHDS) would like to introduce our Mobile Rehab Engineering (MRE) Team. The MRE Team provides on-site DME (Durable Medical Equipment) repairs, safety assessments and pressure washing services to individuals in the Commonwealth of Virginia at schools, private residences, day programs, group homes, work venues, etc. What qualifies as DME? Examples: manual /power wheelchairs, shower chairs, toileting chairs, standers, gait trainers, walkers, rollators, hospital beds, helmets, canes, etc. Our MRE Team includes DME rehabilitation engineers & technicians, a physical therapist/assistive technology professional (PT/ATP), an occupational therapist (OT) and a Registered Nurse Care Consultant/assistive technology professional (RNCC/ATP). The MRE Team's mission is to provide DME maintenance and repair services to individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, who don't have these services currently provided to them in the community. The MRE Team's goal is to reduce barriers and access to community based care and activities through improved DME functionality & safety. Routine safety assessments can also extend the life of DME by identifying repair needs early. The MRE Team will also provide PT, OT, AT & DME-related trainings and resource information as needed/requested.
