Important information about the current IFSP-Funding cycle

Over the past few months, DBHDS has worked to make critical enhancements to this program. These enhancements include the design of a new application that is now part of the WaMS system (the Virginia Waiver Management System), and new emergency regulations and guidelines that have been approved.

IFSP released an official Funding announcement via our email list on January 10th.
