## **ADVOCATE REPORT AND TRAINING**

### **Quarterly Complaint Statistics**

For the quarter ending 12/31/2022 in Region 1:

- **37** Complaints involving allegations of ANE (CSB)
- **482** Complaints involving allegations of ANE (Providers)
- **5** Complaints not involving ANE (CSB)
- **11** Complaints not involving ANE (Providers)

This is an increase of 64 total complaints from Q3 to Q4. Of Q4's 535 total complaints, 42 allegations involving ANE were substantiated. This is a percentage of 12.7% 5.67% substantiated cases, which is an increase of 7.03% between Q3 to Q4 for ANE substantiated cases.
