Training Title & Description
<p>❖ Reporting in CHRIS</p> <p>This training is designed to educate the learner on the human rights complaint process and provider reporting requirements specific to abuse and neglect allegations. The learner will increase their understanding of CHRIS and the Human Rights Regulations regarding human rights complaints and reporting.</p>
<p>❖ Investigating Abuse & Neglect: The Basics</p> <p>This training is designed as an overview of the regulatory and investigative process, specific to the investigation of abuse and neglect.</p>
<p>❖ Overview of the Human Rights Regulations</p> <p>This training is designed to provide the learner an in-depth review of the Human Rights Regulations. Providers will increase their understanding of the Office of Human Rights processes and the responsibilities of the provider as mandated by the Human Rights Regulations.</p>
<p>❖ Restrictions, Behavioral Treatment Plans, & Restraints</p> <p>This training is designed to educate the learner on regulatory requirements related to the use of restrictions, behavioral treatment plans, and restraints.</p>
